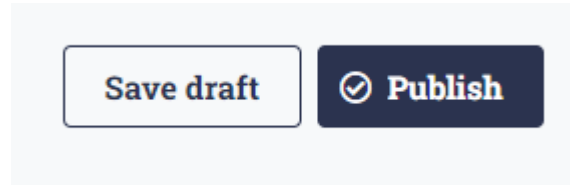

- Finally, you can set your payment terms.
- You can choose to be paid when job is completed.
- Or you can choose payment terms. This means once the job is completed you will receive payment in X number of days (i.e. Net 10, 30 etc.)
- Job completion is triggered by either the end date the customer requested the services by or the customer manually changing the status to complete
